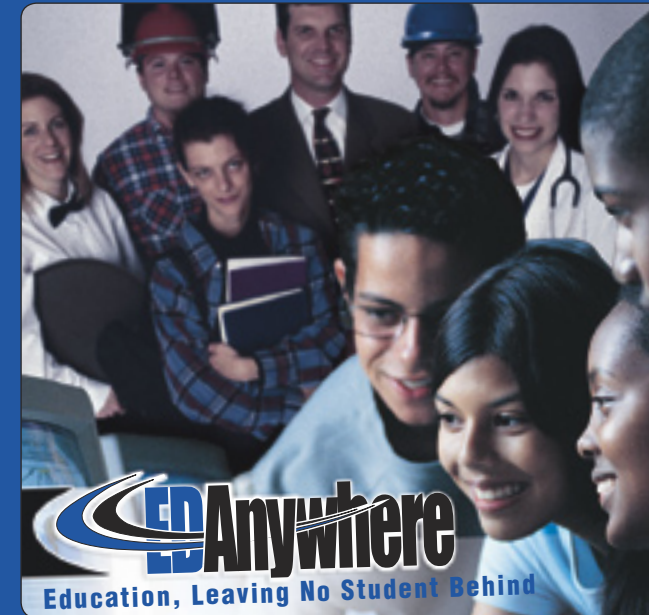

Frequently Asked Questions

What are distance-learning courses?

These are credit courses that are taught to students who are separated by time and/or space from the instructor.


Who should take distance-learning courses?

Our distance-learning program is designed for middle and high school students (*ages 13 and up*) who are:

- unable to successfully complete traditional school-based programs.
- seeking to earn extra credits or to repeat a failed course.
- needing to master basic skills.
- long-term suspended, expelled, or who have left school.

Is a diploma available through distance learning?

Yes! Our program permits students to earn an accredited high school diploma – not a GED. Our program has been developed by Home Study International, a nationally recognized Distance Education and Training Council, and it is accredited by the Middle States Association for Schools and Colleges.

What kind of computer equipment do I need?

All that is needed to get started is access to the web and the web browser, Internet Explorer.

Do I need to buy textbooks?

Our program contains a set of online textbooks for each core subject. These e-textbooks and the accompanying course lessons have been linked to more than 5,000 web sites that can be used for enrichment purposes.

How many credits do I need?

A total of 21 Carnegie units (*high school credits*) are required to complete your diploma.

How much does it cost?

Tuition for distance learning courses is \$300 per month, plus a \$25 application fee. You may take up to 6 courses at a time. See costs for other related services on our website.


What if I want a refund?

You are financially and academically responsible for all classes in which you enroll. If you wish to discontinue high school attendance, you must officially withdraw by completing a withdrawal form.


If you decide not to proceed with any course, it is your responsibility to withdraw.
